Koshimizu Wild Flower Park located in Abashiri Quasi-National Park

Koshimizu Wild Flower Park is a coastal park that represents Hokkaido. The narrow sand dune in between the Sea of Okhotsk and Lake Tofutsu. is a natural wildflower reserve. Flowers in the reserve begin to bloom from late May, reaching their peak between mid-June and early July, and continue to bloom well into early September. Over 200 varieties of flowers, such as Siberian lilies, daylilies, and rugosa roses, can be enjoyed throughout the season. For a short time during the flowering season, Genseikaen Station is open for convenient access to the reserve. The Sea of Okhotsk and the sight of the train running through fields of colorful flowers, draws out the sentiment of the traveler. In October of 2004, Koshimizu Wild Flower Park was designated as a Hokkaido Heritage that will be handed down to the next generation.

■Michinoeki (Road Station) Hanayaka Koshimizu

Road Station Hanayaka Koshimizu is a unique multipurpose facility in the way that it is directly connected to JR Hama-koshimizu Station. Promoting "clean agriculture in Koshimizu," it houses a café and rest area and displays local specialty products for sale. The facility also has a panel exhibition area and offers classes on how to make bread miso, sausages, ice cream and other processed foods.

■ Lake Tofutsu, a Ramsar Site

Lake Tofutsu was listed under the Convention on Wetlands of International Importance, the Ramsar Convention in November of 2005. The lake, 27.3 km in circumference, and 900 hectares in area, gets its name from the Ainu word, "Toputsu (mouth of the lake)." It is known as one of important stopovers for swans and other migratory birds. Between early June and November, pastured horses along the lakeside create idyllic landscape, typical of eastern

The new Lake Tofutsu boardwalk was installed along the lakeside, in front of the Koshimizu Wild Flower Information Center Hana. Visitors can get a feel of the wild birds, wildflowers and spectacular views of nature surrounding the lake, up close.

The Koshimizu Lily Park, covering 13 hectares in area, is run by local ornamental lily farmers. Inside the park, a million lilies from all over the world such as Casa Blanca, Fata Morgana, Marco Polo, and Elite bloom over 7 million flowers, from mid July to early September inspiring all visitors.






Koshimizu Onsen Fureai Center



Highland Koshimizu 725, sits 725 meters above sea level, near the 8th station on Mt. Mokoto, a mountain 1000 meters high, on the northern edge of the Akan National Park, This rest stop on the side of the mountain offers the most spectacular views of the Sea of Okhotsk, Shiretoko Mountain Range, Lake Kussharo, Mt. Io-zan in Kawayu, and the Wakoto Peninsula. On a clear early morning, you just might even be able to catch a glimpse of the cloud sea, another attractive aspect of the vast nature here.


